After check-in I'll present today's discussion topic, and we'll start with an around the circle question about it. At 10 minutes before the end of the meeting I will make announcements, then we will check out. During checkout you can thank someone for something they said, say what was most meaningful to you about the meeting, or give us any other final thought.

SMART uses a self-empowering approach. We work to develop our own capacity and strength to address our problems and to live a more meaningful life. We focus on changing our own beliefs and behaviors to bring them more in line with facts, logic, our goals, and our values. How helpful today's meeting will be will depend largely on how much participants open up and entrust us with their deeper thoughts and feelings.
